NEW FAST COURSES NOW AVAILABLE

Two new courses, <u>UK HealthCare Payroll</u> and <u>Grant Account Closeout</u>, have been added to the <u>FAST Source Library</u> in <u>myUK Learning</u>.

<u>UK HealthCare Payroll</u> discusses Kronos and why it is important. This includes leave request features, Kronos modules such as Leave, Attendance, as well as FMLA. The course also covers time manager responsibilities and finalizing timecards, as well as how to add pay codes and track certification expiration.

<u>Grant Account Closeout</u> focuses on the grant account in SAP that is used to account for sponsored project financial activity. The course covers when a grant closeout is

due, the timelines for account close communication, review and account closure, and finally the importance of a timely closeout.



NEW YEAR, NEW COMPLIANCE CYCLE

- Remember that mandatory participants are to complete two (2) unique FAST courses before the deadline of June 30, 2024.
- Take into consideration any planned leave to be prepared for the course deadline.
- Participants can choose their courses by clicking on "CHOOSE COURSES" next to the "FAST TRAINING CYCLE" in their LEARNING PLAN. There are now 25 FAST courses to choose from!
